

# FEES and TERM DATES from APRIL 2025

**Two, Three- and four-year-old children** are eligible for Universal Government Funding for up to 15 hours per week for 38 weeks each year which can be shared between two providers of nursery education. Subject to meeting criteria, working families may be eligible for an Extended 15 hours Government Funding which can be applied for at <u>www.childcarechoices.gov.uk.</u>

Please note that the extended hours for working families of two-year-old children is effective from September 2025 and are eligible from the term after their second birthday.

A working families code for all age groups should be applied for by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2025 to be eligible for use in Autumn Term 2025.

If your household income is less than £16,190, some children may be entitled to 2-year-old targeted funding for up to 15 hours per week which can be applied for at <a href="http://www.bracknell-forest.gov.uk">www.bracknell-forest.gov.uk</a>. UNIVERSAL EARLY EDUCATION IS FUNDED BY THE GOVERNMENT when a child reaches the age of three

#### Nursery opening times -

Morning session 9.30 am to 12.30 pm Afternoon session 12.30pm – 3.30pm Full day session 9.30am – 3.30pm

Government funding can be used flexibly for all hours offered without artificial breaks.

Fees for unfunded children or hours in excess of those funded:	£8.75	per hour
<b>Registration Fee for non-funded hours (Non-refundable)</b> or for a place on the waiting list of nursery if your are not in receipt of government funding:	£35.00	per child

A VOLUNTARY consumables/enhancements charge of £1.50 per morning session and £1.50 per afternoon session is appreciated for all government funded children except for children in receipt of Targeted funding or Early Years Pupil Premium.

Parents/carers wishing to opt out of this charge can do so and will be required to provide a snack for their child each session, in addition you will be provided with a list of consumables/enhancements which you will need to provide for your child each term, to be provided on/before the first day of term.

The definition od a consumable includes nappies, wipes, nappy sacs and sun cream. The definition of enhancements is the celebration of festivals, outings, special activities and extra curriculum activities. Additional ad hoc nursery sessions booked will incur an additional administration charge of £0.75 per hour.

Six weeks' notice is required before the removal of a child or six weeks fees will be payable in lieu of notice. The notice does not include holiday periods when the nursery is closed.

Fees are payable termly in advance, by the end of the first week of attendance in any one term. Late payment of fees will incur a handling charge of £2.50 per day.
